CHILDREN IN WORSHIP

Young children are welcome to join our worship at Covenant Community Church. If vou anticipate that your young child or children cannot exercise necessary self-control to remain relatively quiet and still, please consider making good use of either our nursery or our training room out of consideration for your fellow worshipers—particularly during the preaching of the Word.

OVERFLOW SEATING

Our overflow seating area can be found in the fellowship hall (our lowest level) during the morning service. Please maintain the same quiet and order in the overflow space as in the main sanctuary. A child-training area for parents of young children can be found on the middle floor.

THE LORD'S SUPPER

We look forward to celebrating the Lord's Supper in our evening worship service today.

The Lord's Supper is a meal in which we enjoy communion with God and with His covenant people, the church. If you are a

member in good standing of a Bible-believing evangelical church, you are welcome to join with us at the Lord's Table. If you are not formally joined to Christ's church, we ask you to refrain from partaking of the Lord's Supper.

If you have any questions about the Lord's Supper, or if you desire to join Christ's church, please speak with our pastors or elders (you will notice the elders serving the Lord's Supper) after our worship service.

DIACONAL OFFERING

This evening we will take up our diaconal offering (for mercy ministry) immediately after the celebration of the Lord's Supper. This offering is a fitting expression of our care for one another in the body of Christ.

HIGH SCHOOL CLASS

Our high school Sunday School class meets in the fellowship hall. We are reading a book entitled 12 Ways Your Phone Is Changing You by Tony Reinke. We plan to study this book over the next weeks in both our high school fellowship gatherings and our high school Sunday School class.
